BYLAW NO. 2024-09

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF HEAVY MOTOR VEHICLES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lac Pelletier No. 107 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. In this Bylaw the expression:
 - a. "Public Highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated pursuant to the Act;
 - b. "Heavy Vehicle" shall mean a vehicle with or without load which alone or together with any trailer, semi-trailer or other vehicle being towed, weighs 10 Tonne (9,842 tons) or more.
- 2. No person shall operate a heavy vehicle at a greater speed than sixty (60) kilometers per hour on any public highways within the Rural Municipality of Lac Pelletier No. 107.
- 3. Signs indicating the maximum speed and weight shall be erected where appropriate.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of the Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provide in the General Penalty Bylaw of this Municipality.
